Present civil revision has been filed against the judgment and decree dated 09.08.2018 passed by learned Rent Controller, Dasuya and judgment and decree dated 14.10.2019 passed by learned Appellate Authority, Hoshiarpur, whereby petitioner-tenant was directed to hand over possession of the demised shop to the respondent-landlord.
