Matter has been taken up through video conferencing via Webex facility in the light of the Pandemic Covid-19 situation and as per instructions.

Instant petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. praying for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.122, dated 24.11.2019, under Sections 406, 498-A IPC, registered at Police Station Kalanaur, District Gurdaspur.

Vide order dated 28.01.2022, while granting interim protection, the petitioner was directed to join investigation.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that pursuant to the order dated 28.01.2022, the petitioner has joined the investigation and as such his interim bail may be made absolute. He further submits that the parties were referred to mediation and they duly appeared before the

Mediator is also placed on record showing that the dispute is amicably settled between the parties.
