This writ petition has been filed challenging order dated 11.03.2019 passed by the Divisional Canal Officer and communication dated 21.05.2019 sent by the Executive Canal Officer. The petitioner had applied for restoration of a demolished water course, but the same was rejected and appeal there-against has been dismissed on account of limitation.

A perusal of the order dated 11.03.2019 passed by the Divisional Canal Officer shows that a finding of fact has been returned that there is no evidence of demolition of a water course.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has not been able to show that the said finding is perverse and thus, even though, the appeal has been dismissed on the ground of the limitation, no interference is called for.

The writ petition is, accordingly, dismissed.
