Petitioner has approached this Court praying for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.36 dated 18.07.2019, under Sections 498-A, 406, 34 of Indian Penal Code, registered at Police Station Women Cell Bathinda, District Bathinda.

This Court granted the interim bail to the petitioner on 17.12.2019 and vide order dated 30.07.2021, the matter was referred to the Mediation and Conciliation Centre of this Court as well. The petitioner was granted numerous opportunities to pay the amount of maintenance to the complainant as amicably settled. Despite number of opportunities granted to the petitioner, he has shown no inclination for complying the same. The anticipatory bail is an extraordinary relief whereas, his conduct does not deserves the same. Despite having been shown the indulgence by this Court, repeatedly the petitioner has not shown any respect and regard to the same.

In view of the above, no ground is made out to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioner and the petitioner stands dismissed accordingly.
