1. Prayer in the petition is for initiating proceedings against the respondents for intentional and willful defiance of order, Annexure P-1, dated 29.02.2016, in CWP-14106-2011.

2. Learned counsel contends that although the petitioners have been regularized pursuant to order Annexure P/1 dated 29.02.2016, yet the regularization is not w.e.f. the date of entitlement, therefore, the petitioners do not wish to pursue the instant petition but pray for permission to withdraw the same with liberty to challenge the action of the respondents in not granting regularization w.e.f. the date of entitlement in terms of policy applicable, by way of appropriate proceedings in accordance with law.

3. In view of the position noted above, as well as statement of learned counsel for the petitioners, the instant petition is *disposed of* as not calling for any action against the respondents under the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971, while granting liberty to the petitioner as prayed for.
