[1] Prayer in the petition is for initiating proceedings against the respondents for intentional and willful defiance of order, Annexure P/1, dated 27.05.2019 in CWP No.14327 of 2019 in case titled as Baljeet Singh vs. State of Punjab and others.

[2] A perusal of order, Annexure P/1 reveals that CWP No.14327 of 2019 was disposed of by directing the respondents to decide representation dated 23.05.2018 within three months from the date of receipt of certified copy of the order and in case the petitioner was found entitled to any monetary benefits after the decision of the said representation, to release the same to him within three months thereafter.

[3] At the outset, learned counsel for the petitioner states that although claim of the petitioner as contained in representation dated 23.05.2018 was decided vide order dated 27.08.2019 but payment of monetary benefits was released to the petitioner only in December, 2019, therefore, he does not press the instant petition but prays for grant of

liberty to the petitioner to claim interest on the delayed release of monetary benefits of approximately Rs.6,00,000/- by way of appropriate proceedings in accordance with law.

[4] The same is not opposed to by the learned counsel for the respondents.

[5] In view of the position noted above as well as the statement of learned counsel for the parties, the instant petition is disposed of as not calling for any action against the respondents under the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971 while granting liberty to the petitioner as prayed for.

[6] Rule discharged.
