[1] Prayer in the petition is for initiating proceedings against the respondents for intentional and willful defiance of order, Annexure P-1, dated 23.07.2019, in CWP No.19949 of 2019 in case titled as '**Bikar Singh versus State of Punjab and others**'.

[2] A perusal of order (Annexure P-1), reveals that CWP No.19949 of 2019, was disposed of by directing the respondents to decide legal notice dated 03.05.2019 within three months from the date of receipt of certified copy of the order.

[3] Learned counsel contends that decision has been taken by the respondents vide order (Annexure R-1) dated 14.02.2020 in terms of order (Annexure P-1) dated 23.07.2019 in CWP No.19949 of 2019 accepting part of the claim and releasing benefits, therefore, in the circumstances, the petitioner is not interested in pursuing the instant petition and may be permitted to withdraw the same with liberty to challenge order

(Annexure R-1) dated 14.02.2020 to the extent the same denies, the benefits claimed by way of appropriate proceedings, in accordance with law.

[4] In view of the position noted above, as well as statement of learned counsel for the petitioner, the instant petition is *disposed of* as not calling for any action against the respondents under the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971, while granting liberty to the petitioner as prayed for.
