[1] Prayer in the petition is for initiation of proceedings against the respondents for intentional and willful breach of undertaking given by way of affidavit (Annexure P-10) in CWP No.19436 of 2019 as also of intentional and willful defiance of order (Annexure P-1) dated 27.05.2019 in CWP No.4966 of 2019.

[2] At the outset, learned counsel for the petitioners states that CWP No.4966 of 2019 has been disposed of as infructuous vide order dated 15.09.2022, therefore, he does not press the instant petition.

[3] In view of the position noted above, as well as statement of learned counsel for the petitioners, the instant petition is *disposed of* as not calling for any action against the respondents under the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971.
