The instant petition under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure has been filed seeking issuance of direction to respondent No. 2 to conduct enquiry against the private respondents regarding wrongful withdrawal of Rs. 22 Lakhs from bank account of Gurudwara Singh Sabha and misappropriating of the same.

Learned State counsel has contended, on instructions from ASI Parvesh Kumar, that the matter has already been amicably resolved amongst the parties and as per the said compromise, they did not want to proceed any further in the complaint against the private respondents.

Learned counsel appearing for the petitioner pleads ignorance of any such settlement.

In view of the statement made by learned State counsel, the present petition is dismissed as not pressed. Liberty is, however, granted to the petitioner to revive the instant petition in case the statement made by learned State counsel is found to be false.
