Petitioners have filed this petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for quashing of FIR No.160 dated 04.08.2016 under Sections 379-B IPC registered at Jandiala, District Amritsar (Rural), and all other consequential proceedings arising out of the said FIR, as the matter stands amicably settled in terms of compromise and affidavit dated 04.08.2018 (Annexures P-2 and P-3).

Vide order dated 11.12.2018, the parties were directed to appear before the trial Court/Ilaqa Magistrate on 04.01.2019 for getting their statements recorded with regard to the compromise and the learned Magistrate was directed to send a report about the genuineness and veracity of the compromise.

A report dated 22.01.2019 of learned JMIC, Amritsar has been received. As per the report, the parties had appeared before learned Magistrate and got recorded their statements regarding compromise.

Learned Magistrate has stated that she is of the considered view that the

compromise between the parties is valid, genuine, voluntary and without any coercion or undue influence.

Accordingly, the present petition is allowed. FIR No.160 dated 04.08.2016 under Sections 379-B IPC registered at Jandiala, District Amritsar (Rural), along with all subsequent proceedings arising therefrom, are hereby quashed qua the petitioners.
