AVNEESH JHINGAN, J (Oral):

This petition was filed seeking directions to Station House Officer, Police Station Jandiala Guru, Teh. & District Amritsar to take action against respondents No. 4 to 7 (arrayed in the petition). The grievance is that the applications dated 24.10.2018 and 27.11.2018 were not considered and decided.

On notice of motion, reply was filed by the State. Paragraph 6 of the reply is quoted below:

“6. That in so far as the applications No. 4281-PP dated 28.8.201 and 5111-PP dated 24.10.18 given by the petitioner against the respondents No. 6 and 7 are concerned, it is submitted that after enquiry into this application, preventive proceedings under Section 107, 151, 150 of Cr.P.C. has been initiated vide DDR No. 28 dated 16.2.2019 against the respondent No. 6 and 7, Sher Singh and Kehar Singh. Therefore, the present petition is liable to be dismissed on

the basis of these grounds.”

Learned counsel for the State on instructions from ASI-Joginder Pal Singh submits that the applications dated 28.8.2018 and 24.10.2018 have been considered and a formal order would be passed within three weeks from today. The petitioner can collect the order from the concerned police station on any working day, after three weeks.

In view of the above, the present petition is disposed of.

It is clarified that the petitioner would be at liberty to avail remedies in accordance with law for redressal of the surviving grievances, if any.
