AMAN CHAUDHARY, J.

The present petition under Section 482 of Cr.P.C. has been filed for issuing direction to respondent Nos.1 and 2 to inquire the case FIR No.85 dated 01.07.2019 registered under Sections 323, 324, 326 and 34 IPC at Police Station Doraha (Annexure P-1).

Notice of motion was issued in this case on 18.12.2019. Pursuant to which short reply dated 17.11.2022 had been filed. Learned State counsel makes a reference to para Nos.5 and 6 of the same, which reads thus:-

“5. That the report U/s 173 Cr.P.C. was presented in the court of SDJM, Payal on 02.02.2021 while putting Sukhchain Singh @ Sukhi in column no.2 of the report, where the charges have been framed against the accused. Till today no witness has been examined and now the case is fixed for 31.10.2022 before the learned trial Court.

6. That as the challan has been presented before the learned trial Court. Now the case is fixed before the learned trial court for prosecution evidence. At present without the permission of the learned trial Court, the Special Investigation Team cannot be constituted as the matter is pending before the learned trial court.”

In view of the reply, learned counsel for the State submits that this case has been rendered infructuous and may be disposed of as such.

Accordingly, no further order is required to be passed in the matter and the present petition stands disposed of as having been rendered infructuous.
