This writ petition was filed seeking directions to respondents No. 2 and 3 to protect the life and liberty of petitioner from the hands of private respondents (arrayed in petition) and also against false implication in a criminal case.

From the pleadings, it is forth coming that there was dispute between the petitioner and M/s Mohinder Singh and Sons with regard to issuance of J-form. It was alleged that the petitioner was forcibly taken to the police station on 11.12.2019. Further that local police Nabha at the behest of private respondents was harassing the petitioner.

Learned State counsel has filed reply dated 23.2.2021. In the reply it is pleaded that the representation of petitioner was marked to DSP Nabha Circle, Patiala. After enquiry he submitted a report with the conclusion that the petitioner was selling his crops through the commission agent. There was dispute with regard to settlement of accounts. Considering that the matter was civil in nature, consigning of application was recommended.

In view of reply filed, no further directions are called for.

The petition is disposed of.

Needless to say that the petitioner would be at liberty to avail remedy in accordance with law for redressal of the surviving grievance if any.

Since the main case has been disposed of, the pending application, if any is rendered infructuous.
