1. Prayer in the petition is for initiating proceedings against the respondent for intentional and willful defiance of order, Annexure P-1, dated 14.09.2018, in CWP-23473-2018.

2. A perusal of order, Annexure P-1, dated 14.09.2018, reveals that CWP-23473-2018, was disposed of by directing respondent No.1 to look into representations dated 29.03.2016 and 06.12.2017, filed by the petitioner and pass appropriate orders in respect thereto in accordance with law within four months.

3. At the outset, learned counsel for the petitioner states that pursuant to order dated 14.01.2020, calling for compliance report, the respondents have passed order dated 17.09.2020, rejecting the claim of the petitioner as contained in the aforementioned representations, therefore, in the circumstances, the petitioners are not interested in pursuing the instant petition and may be permitted to withdraw the same with liberty to challenge order dated 17.09.2020, by way of appropriate proceedings, in

accordance with law.

4. In view of the position noted above, as well as statement of learned counsel for the petitioners, the instant petition is *disposed of* as not calling for any action against the respondents under the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971, while granting liberty to the petitioner as prayed for.
