Prayer in this writ petition is for issuance of directions to the respondents to release the proper pension/retiral benefits of the petitioner.

As per the written statement filed on behalf of respondents no.1 to 3, it is stated in the preliminary objection that pension and all other retiral benefits due to the petitioner have been released as per order dated 13.04.2018 (Annexure R-1/1) vide bill no. 195 dated 18.12.2018, therefore, the present writ petition has been rendered infructuous.

It is noticed that none had appeared on behalf of the petitioner on the last two occasions when this writ petition was taken up for hearing. Today again there is no representation on behalf of the petitioner. It appears that the petitioner is not interested in pursuing the matter any longer. Writ petition is dismissed in default.
