**MEENAKSHI I. MEHTA, J.(Oral)**

The petitioner herein has sought the indulgence of this Court for the issuance of a writ in the nature of certiorari for quashing the order dated 22.11.2019 (Annexure P-3) passed by respondent No.2 and also the report dated 18.11.2019 (Annexure P-2) given by respondent No.3 qua the rejection of the application moved by him for seeking parole and he has, further, prayed for the issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus for granting him parole for 04 (four) weeks for the repair of his house.

Reply on behalf of the respondents has already been filed.

However, learned State counsel, on the instructions from ASI Subhash

Chander, from Police Station Sadar Hisar, District Hisar, apprises the Court that the petitioner had been released on parole on 26.08.2020 and was scheduled to surrender back in the jail on 03.10.2021 but he has not surrendered before the jail authorities till date and a criminal case has also been registered against him on this count at Police Station Sadar Hisar vide FIR No.934 dated 13.10.2021.

In view of the above-discussed submission as made by learned State counsel, it is explicit that the petitioner does not deserve the relief as sought by him in this petition and the same deserves dismissal. Resultantly, the petition in hand stands dismissed.
