IOIN-CRM-M-41777-2018

This petition was disposed off by the Coordinate Bench of this Court vide order dated 21.09.2018 with the following directions:-

“Both the petitioners are present in Court. 2nd petitioner namely Gurjant Singh has assured that he will make necessary arrangement for depositing a sum of Rs.1,00,000/- in the name of 1st petitioner in the shape of FDR for a period of three years within a period of three months from today. He is directed to deposit the copy of the FDR in the Registry of this Court within three months, in case he fails to do so, Registry is directed to list this matter on 24.012019.

Accordingly, the petition is disposed of.”

However, this order was not complied by petitioner No.2-Gurjant Singh and the matter was put up by the Registry for necessary orders and vide order dated 12.07.2022, bailable warrants were issued for

securing the presence of petitioner No.2, and were to be executed by the Senior Superintendent of Police, Amritsar (Rural) and the matter was adjourned for today.

Counsel for the petitioner states that the order dated 21.09.2018 has been complied with and petitioner No.2 has made FDR of Rs.1,10,000/- in the name of petitioner No.1-Neha (Annexure P-7). It is further mentioned in the application that on 29.09.2020, petitioner No.2 has also purchased land measuring 5 Marlas in the name of petitioner No.1 and he has placed on record Registry of the said land as Annexure P-9. It is further stated that the petitioners are living happily and out of their wedlock, a girl child, namely, Avni Sandhu, was born on 03.08.2019.

In view of the above, no further orders are required to be passed.

IOIN stands disposed off accordingly.
