Instant petition has been filed under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 for grant of anticipatory bail in FIR No.100 dated 29.10.2019, registered for offences under Sections 406 and 498-A of the Indian Penal Code, 1860, at Police Station Women Cell, Jalandhar, Punjab, Annexure P-1.

Counsel for the petitioner submits that pursuant to order dated 18.07.2022, the petitioner has joined the investigation. This fact has been ascertained by the State counsel, upon instruction from ASI, Rajesh Kumar, and he further submits that in view of the settlement between the parties, petitioner is no longer required for custodial interrogation.

In view of the above, but without commenting upon the allegations levelled in the FIR, Annexure P-1, petition is allowed. Order dated 18.07.2022 is made absolute, subject to the conditions laid down in Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
