Prayer in the petition is for issuance of direction to respondent No.3 not to harass the petitioners and their family members by calling them to the police station time and again and threatening them to involve in false cases, if the petitioners do not withdraw their representation and to direct respondent No.2 to take action on the representation 16.10.2019 moved by petitioner No.1. Further prayer is to direct respondent No. 2 to get the inquiry conducted in FIR No.243 dated 10.10.2019, registered under Sections 302, 307 IPC and Sections 25, 27 of the Arms Act, at Police Station City Moga, from some senior Police Official.

Today there is no representation on behalf of the petitioners.

Reply dated 11.02.2020 filed on behalf of the respondent-State is
already on file.

Learned State counsel points out that FIR No. 243 dated 10.10.2019, under Sections 302, 307 IPC and Sections 25, 27 of the Arms Act, at Police Station City Moga, was registered on the basis of statement of Varinder Singh; that petitioner No.2-Kuldeep Kumar Singh, who was named as an accused during inquiry, has now been declared as innocent; Apar Singh @ Bittu and Parwinder Singh @ Gabbar, were arrested on 13.10.2019 and 16.10.2019 respectively and the challan against them was presented in the Court of learned Chief Judicial Magistrate, Moga on 04.01.2020 and that the petitioners are not required by the police and they were not harassed by the police at any stage.

Since petitioner No.1 is the wife of Apar Singh @ Bittu, one of the accused in FIR No. 243 dated 10.10.2019, registered under Sections 302, 307 IPC and Sections 25, 27 of the Arms Act, at Police Station City Moga. The challan has been presented. Moreover, as per the reply dated 11.02.2020, the petitioners are not required and the fact that they were also not harassed by the police at any stage and during inquiry petitioner No.2-Kuldeep Kumar Singh has been declared innocent.

In view of the above, no further indulgence is called for in the present petition.

Dismissed.
