1. Prayer in the petition is for initiating proceedings against the respondent for intentional and willful defiance of order, Annexure P/1, dated 12.06.2019, in CRM-M-26689-2019.

2. A perusal of order Annexure P/1 reveals that vide order dated 12.06.2019, CRM-M-26689-2019 was disposed of by directing respondent No.1 to look into representation dated 18.05.2019, filed by the petitioner and decide the same expeditiously within 90 days from the date of receipt of certified copy of the order.

3. At the outset, learned counsel for the petitioner states that although notice has not yet been issued in this case, yet, pursuant to time taken by the learned State counsel to obtain instructions, the respondent has decided the representation filed by the petitioner and challan has been filed in respect of the FIR registered against the accused, therefore, in the circumstances, the petitioner is not interested in pursuing the instant

petition and may be permitted to withdraw the same.

4. In view of the position noted above, as well as statement of learned counsel for the petitioner, the instant petition is *disposed of* as not calling for any action against the respondent under the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971.
