1. Prayer in the petition is for initiating proceedings against the respondents for intentional and willful defiance of order, Annexure P-1, dated 22.08.2019 in CWP-22246-2019.

2. A perusal of order Annexure P-1 dated 22.08.2019, reveals that CWP-22246-2019, was disposed of by directing respondent No.4 i.e. the Divisional Engineer, Punjab Water Resources Management & Development Corporation Limited, Lining Division No.4, Abohar, to examine the claim of the petitioner against the backdrop of legal notice dated 07.07.2019 and take a final decision thereupon expeditiously and in any case within eight weeks from the date of receipt of certified copy of the order and in case any outstanding amount was found due, admissible payment be released to the petitioner without any delay.

3. At the outset, learned counsel for the petitioner states that the

claim as contained in legal notice dated 07.07.2019, was decided by

respondent No.4 and payment as per entitlement determined upon decision of legal notice dated 07.07.2019, has been released to the petitioner, therefore, in the circumstances, the petitioner is not interested in pursuing the instant petition and may be permitted to withdraw the same.

4. In view of the position noted above, as well as statement of learned counsel for the petitioner, the instant petition is *disposed of* as not calling for any action against the respondents under the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971.
