1. Prayer in the petition is fortaking action against the respondent for intentional and willful defiance of order, Annexure P/1 dated 22.08.2019, in CWP-22230-2019.

2. A perusal of order, Annexure P/1 dated 22.08.2019, reveals that CWP-22230-2019, was disposed of by directing the Divisional Engineer, Punjab Water Resources Management and Development Corporation Ltd., Lining Division No.4, Abohar, to examine the claim of the petitioner against the backdrop of legal notice dated 07.07.2019 and take a final decision on the same expeditiously and in any case within eight weeks from the date of receipt of certified copy of the order.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that although the instant petition was filed on account of the failure of the respondent to do the needful, now the respondent has complied with order Annexure P/1 dated 22.08.2019 and also made payment to the petitioner as per his entitlement, therefore, the petitioner does not press the instant petition.

learned counsel for the petitioner, the instant petition is disposed of as not calling for any action against the respondents under the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971.
