

Date of Decision: 22.03.2022

On instructions from SI Om Parkash, learned State counsel states that petitioner No.1, namely, Kailash Chander in CRM-M-54743-2019 has been found to be innocent and offence under Section 148 and 149 have

been deleted.

Learned counsel for the petitioners contends that he withdraws the application qua Kailash Chander-petitioner No.1 in CRM-M-54743-2019 and he further stated that petitioner No.2, namely, Darshana Devi in CRM-M-54743-2019 is the mother in law of the complainant, aged about 65 years.

Petitioner, namely, Dr. Ram Gopal in CRM-M-3149-2020 is the husband of the complainant and vague allegations have been spelt out in the FIR.

The salary of the complainant who is employed in a bank was being credited in her account and the petitioner(s) never forced her to raise any loan or part with her salary.

At the earlier instance, it was directed that no coercive means be adopted against petitioner No.1- Kailash Chander in CRM-M-54743-2019 and petitioner in CRM-M-3149-2020 to facilitate the mediation process.

Adjourned to 22.03.2022.

Meanwhile, it is directed that in the event of arrest, the petitioner No.2- Darshana Devi in CRM-M-54743-2019 and petitioner-Dr. Ram Gopal in CRM-M-3149-2020 be admitted on interim bail on furnishing bail bonds to the satisfaction of the Arresting Officer subject to the condition that they join the investigation and comply with other conditions as specified under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.”

A photocopy of this order be placed on the file of other connected case.

Learned counsel for the petitioner(s) contends that in pursuance of the interim directions issued by this Court, the petitioner(s) have joined the investigation.

Learned State counsel on the instructions of ASI Mukesh Kumar has pointed out that the petitioner(s) have joined the investigation and are no more required for custodial interrogation.

In these set of circumstances, sufficient exceptional circumstances are made out to extend the concession of pre-arrest bail to the petitioner(s). Accordingly, order dated 03.12.2021 qua petitioner No.2 –

CRM-M-3149-2020

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Darshana Devi in CRM-M-54743-2019 and petitioner-Dr. Ram Gopal in CRM-M-3149-2020 is made absolute.

The petition(s) stand allowed.
