1. Prayer in the petition is for initiating proceedings against the respondent for intentional and willful defiance of order, Annexure P/2 dated 10.09.2019, in CWP-11006-2017.

2. A perusal of order Annexure P/2 reveals that CWP-11006-2017, was disposed of vide order dated 10.09.2019, by directing the respondent to consider and decide the claim of the petitioners as contained in legal notice dated 30.04.2017 / CWP-11006-2017, in accordance with law, as expeditiously as possible, preferably within three months from the date of order.

3. At the outset, learned counsel for the petitioners states that pursuant to order Annexure P/2, claim has been decided and benefits as per entitlement released to the petitioners, therefore, in the circumstances, the petitioners are not interested in pursuing the instant petition and may be permitted to withdraw the same.

4. In view of the position noted above, as well as statement of

learned counsel for the petitioners, the instant petition is *disposed of* as not calling for any action against the respondent under the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971.
