Applications for review have been filed of the order dated 09.01.2018, which are barred by 23/58 days in filing the same.

After hearing counsel for the applicants, we are of considered opinion that no case is made out for review, as stress has only made upon the rules, which are applicable for the recruitment and the qualifications required as per the rules. The same is settled principle of law and, thus, no question for review is made out. Even otherwise, the review applications have been filed by the counsel other than the counsel who had argued the matter and, therefore, in view of the law laid down by the Apex Court in '**T.N. Electricity Board and another Vs. N. Raju Reddiar and another**', 1997 AIR (SC) 1005, the review applications at the instance of other counsels are not maintainable.

Resultantly, the applications for condonation of delay of 23/58 days and review applications are dismissed.
