This is a petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for quashing of FIR No. 227 dated 25.12.2016 under Sections 452, 323, 148 and 149 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860 registered at Police Station Division C, District Police Commissionerate Amritsar (Annexure P-1) and all subsequent proceedings arising on the basis of the compromise.

In pursuance of the order dated 09.04.2021 passed by a Coordinate Bench of this Court, a report has been submitted by the Judicial Magistrate 1st Class, Amritsar to the Registrar General of this Court to the effect that the accused persons/petitioners had appeared before the trial Court for recording their statements but neither the complainant nor the victim/injured had appeared.

In view of the above report, present petition is dismissed.

However, liberty is granted to the parties for filing a fresh petition for quashing of the FIR on the basis of compromise in case the compromise is still effective and in case the parties are ready to record their statements in support of the said compromise.
