Matter has been settled *inter se* the parties and the Insurance Company is ready to pay a sum of Rs.6,00,000/- (Rupees Six Lakhs) over and above the amount awarded by the Tribunal in full and final settlement of the claim in this appeal. Mr. Rajbir Singh, counsel for the Insurance Company has no objection if the application under Section 5 of the Limitation Act, 1963 for condonation of delay of 118 days in filing the appeal is allowed.

Accordingly, we dispose of the present appeal alongwith the application for condonation of delay in terms of the settlement.

The demand draft of the above said amount be brought before the Registrar of Lok Adalat, so that the counsel for the claimants can collect the same. The Insurance company has an option to transfer the amount by way of RTGS, on details being furnished by counsel for the claimants. Compliance of this order be made within four weeks, failing which, interest @ 9% per annum shall follow on the abovesaid amount from the date of this order till payment is made.

The concerned Officer of the Lok Adalat Branch/Office shall

issue proper receipt after receiving the draft to learned counsel/representative of the respondent-Insurance Company. The appellant(s)/counsel for the appellant(s) may collect the draft from the office of the Lok Adalat.

Copy of the order be supplied/sent to the counsel/parties and file be returned to the Hon'ble High Court.
