Present petition has been filed under Article 226 of the Constitution, inter alia, for quashing the impugned order dated 17.05.2017 (P-10), vide which Show Cause Notice dated 03.03.2017 was consigned to record-room; order dated 02.01.2017 (P-4) and order dated 17.08.2016 (P-3), thereby complete information, sought by the petitioner under the Right to Information Act, 2006, was not supplied to him.

Learned State Counsel submits that under the Punjab Land Revenue Act, there is a complete procedure prescribed for getting the certified copies of decided or pending case(s), including other pleadings thereto. Thus, petitioner has effective remedy available to obtain the documents in question.

At the time of hearing, no one has appeared on behalf of the petitioner.

In view of the above, it seems that petitioner is not interested in pursuing the present matter.

As a result thereof, there is no option except to dismiss the present petition for non-prosecution.
