[1] Prayer in the instant petition is for initiation of proceedings against the respondents for intentional and willful defiance of order, Annexure P-1, dated 29.07.2019, in CWP No.20682 of 2019 in case titled as '**Hari Pal**versus**State of Punjab and others.**'

[2] A perusal of order (Annexure P-1), reveals that CWP No.20682 of 2019, was disposed of by directing the respondents to decide the claim made in the legal notice dated 14.03.2019 within three months from the date of receipt of certified copy of the order.

[3] Learned Asstt. AG, Punjab, has filed reply along with speaking order (Annexure R-2) dated 17.06.2021, holding the petitioner entitled to certain benefits as per claim made in the legal notice dated 14.03.2019. The same is taken on record. Copy thereof supplied to learned counsel for the petitioner, who on perusal thereof states that in the circumstances, the petitioner does not press the instant petition but may be granted liberty to challenge order (Annexure R-2) dated 17.06.2021 to the extent it denies the relief claimed.

[4] In view of the position noted above, as well as statement of learned counsel for the petitioner, the instant petition is *disposed of* as not calling for any action against the respondents under the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971, while granting liberty to the petitioner as prayed for.
