[1] Prayer in the petition is for initiating proceedings against the respondents for intentional and willful defiance of order, Annexure P/1 dated 30.05.2019 in CWP No.15115 of 2019 in case titled as M/s A.G. Construction Co. vs. Union of India and others.

[2] A perusal of order, Annexure P/1 reveals that CWP No.15115 of 2019 was disposed of by directing respondent No.4 to consider the claim of the petitioner against the backdrop of representation dated 02.05.2019 and take a decision thereon expeditiously and in any case within eight weeks from the date of receipt of certified copy of the order and if any amount was found due, the same was ordered to be released forthwith.

[3] At the outset, learned counsel for the petitioner states that pursuant to the status report having been called for from respondent No.4 vide order dated 06.01.2020, representation dated 02.05.2019 has been decided by respondent No.4 and payment as per entitlement has

petitioner is not interested in pursuing the instant petition and may be permitted to withdraw the same.

[4] In the light of the position noted above as well as the statement of learned counsel for the petitioner, the contempt petition is disposed of as not calling for any action against respondent No.4 under the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971.
