[1] Prayer in the petition is for initiating proceedings against the respondents for intentional and willful defiance of order, Annexure P/1 dated 01.05.2019 in CWP No.11267 of 2019.

[2] A perusal of order, Annexure P/1 reveals that CWP No.11267 of 2019 was disposed of by directing respondent No.5 to consider the claim of the petitioner against the backdrop of legal notice dated 28.02.2019 and take a decision thereon within eight weeks from the date of receipt of certified copy of the order and in case, any amount was found due, to release the same forthwith.

[3] At the outset, learned counsel for the petitioner states that pursuant to order dated 06.01.2020 calling for status report from respondent No.5, claim of the petitioner as contained in legal notice dated 28.02.2019 has been decided and payment as per entitlement released to the petitioner, therefore, in the circumstances, the petitioner is not interested in pursuing the instant petition and may be permitted to withdraw the same.

[4] In view of the position noted above as well as the statement of learned counsel for the petitioner, the instant petition is disposed of as not calling for any action against respondent No.5 under the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971.
