In the present case, the claim of the petitioner is for the grant of pensionary benefits to the petitioner, who was working in the Haryana Roadways and upon his conviction in a criminal case, he was dismissed from service. The petitioner approached the respondents for reconsidering the order of dismissal and to grant him the pensionary benefits by filing a legal notice dated 20.11.2019 (Annexure P-2), which is still pending consideration with the authorities concerned as of now.

Learned counsel for the respondents, keeping in view the prayer, which is for deciding the legal notice, undertakes that concerned authority will pass appropriate orders on the legal notice dated 20.11.2019 (Annexure P-2) within a period of eight weeks and after the decision with

respect to the legal notice, the petitioner if found entitled for any benefit, the

same will be released within a period of eight weeks thereafter.

Keeping in view the statement of the learned counsel for the respondents and without commenting upon the merits of the case or about the entitlement of the petitioner for the relief which has been claimed by him in the legal notice dated 20.11.2019 (Annexure P-2), the present writ petition is disposed of with a direction to the respondent No.3 to decide the legal notice dated 20.11.2019 (Annexure P-2) within a period of eight weeks from the date of receipt of copy of this order.

In case, after the decision of the legal notice, it is found that the petitioner is entitled for any monetary benefits, the same should also be paid to the petitioner within eight weeks thereafter.
