1. Prayer in the petition is for initiating proceedings against the respondent for intentional and willful defiance of order, Annexure P-1, dated 08.07.2019, in CWP-18123-2019.

2. A perusal of order Annexure P-1 reveals that CWP-18123-2019, was disposed of by directing the Executive Engineer, Construction Division, PWD B&R Branch, Mukerian, District Hoshiarpur, to examine the claim of the petitioner against the backdrop of legal notice dated 31.05.2019, expeditiously and in any case within eight weeks from the date of receipt of certified copy of the order and in case any amount was found due to the petitioner, to release the same to the petitioner, without any further delay.

3. At the outset, learned counsel for the petitioner states that a sum of Rs.11,55,074/- as was found payable to the petitioner vide speaking order dated 13.08.2019, has since been released to the petitioner, therefore, the petitioner does not press the instant petition but prays for

grant of liberty for taking out appropriate proceedings, in accordance with law, to claim interest on delayed release of payment.

4. Accordingly, in view of the position noted above, as well as statement of learned counsel for the petitioner, the instant petition is *disposed of* as not calling for any action against the respondents under the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971, while granting liberty to the petitioner as prayed for.
