This is a petition filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India seeking issuance of a writ in the nature of Certiorari for quashing the impugned order 14.11.2019 (Annexure P-15) passed by the District Magistrate-cum-Appellate Authority, under the Maintenance & Welfare of Parents & Senior Citizens Act, 2007, with certain other prayers made in the present petition.

A perusal of the previous order shows that vide order dated 31.12.2019, the petitioners had undertaken to vacate the premises in question within a period of four months. However, the said order has not been complied with even after passing a period of more than two years. Therefore, the petitioners deserve to be non-suited for this reason only.

In view of the above, this Court does not find it appropriate to proceed further with the present petition.

Dismissed.

The pending miscellaneous application, if any, is also disposed of as such.
