The petitioner seeks grant of anticipatory bail under Section 438 Cr.P.C in case bearing FIR No.189 dated 10.12.2019 registered under Section 22 of Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act, 1985 at Police Station Sadar Sri Muktsar, District Sri Muktsar Sahib.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in compliance of the order dated 15.01.2020, petitioner has joined the investigation to the entire satisfaction of the Investigating Officer.

Learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Kulwant Singh admits the aforesaid fact and submits that the petitioner is no more required for further investigation in the case.

In view of aforesaid factual position, the interim order dated 15.01.2020 is made absolute. However, the petitioner shall keep on joining the investigation as and when required to do so and he shall abide by the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
