Suffice it would be to reiterate that the concerned Respondents shall look into the grievances raised by the present Petitioner with regard to the alleged illegal construction and the decision shall be taken after giving an opportunity of hearing to all the stakeholders including the Petitioner herein.

Needless to state that in case the Respondents come to a conclusion that the construction in question is illegal or unauthorised, necessary action shall be taken in accordance with law.
