1. Present application has been filed for condonation of delay of 10 days in filing the present petition.
2. For the reasons mentioned in the application, the delay of 10 days in filing the petition is condoned.
3. The application stands disposed of.

4. Learned senior counsel for the petitioners submits that he would be satisfied if the certified copy of judgment passed in Civil Suit bearing no.425588/2016 dated 30.03.2019 titled as *Ram Kishan vs. Moti Lal &*

Ors. is allowed to be taken on record and the same is considered by learned trial court in accordance with the law. Learned senior counsel submits that if this is allowed, he has instructions not to press present petition and the petition may be disposed of accordingly.

5. Learned senior counsel for the respondents has gracefully submitted that he has no objection to the same and the certified copy of Civil Suit bearing no.425588/2016 dated 30.03.2019 titled as *Ram Kishan vs. Moti Lal & Ors.* may be allowed to be taken on record.
