ORAL ORDER

2 04-05-2023 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned
A.P.P. for the State.

The petitioner apprehends his arrest in a case registered
for the offences punishable under Section 498 (A) of the Indian
Penal Code and 4 of Dowry Prohibition Act.

Allegedly, petitioner, along with other family members,
tortured upon the complainant physically and mentally. They
also tried to kill her.

It is submitted by learned counsel for the petitioner that
petitioner is quite innocent and has committed no offence. No
such occurrence as alleged ever took place. Petitioner is father-
in-law of the complainant. He has been falsely implicated in



this case due to ulterior motive. The allegation levelled against the petitioner is not specific rather general and omnibus in nature. He has no concern with the complainant and her husband as he has been residing separately from his son. Petitioner has no criminal antecedent as mentioned in para-3 of this application.

Learned APP for the State opposed the prayer for bail.

Having regard to the facts and circumstances of the case, there is no specific overt act against the petitioner, let the above named petitioner, be released on bail, in the event of his arrest or surrender before the learned Court below within a period of six weeks from today, on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 25,000/- (Rupees Twenty Five Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned Court below where the case is pending/successor Court in connection with Complaint Case No. 1990 (C) of 2016, subject to the condition as laid down under Section 438 (2) of the Cr.P.C.
