- 2 15-09-2023 1. The present petition has been filed for restoration of a writ petition bearing CWJC No.21091 of 2021, which has stood dismissed on account of non-prosecution by an order dated 07.11.2022.
2. The learned counsel for the petitioner has



submitted that the counsel for the petitioner was suffering from Dengue fever therefore, he could not attend the hearing of the case, when the case was called out for hearing on 07.11.2022, thus, a sympathetic view be taken and the aforesaid petition be restored to its original file.
