appointed on basis of compassion
by the respondent No. 3 the
Chairman of District Compassionate
Committee, Muzaffarpur under the
Chairmanship of District Magistrate,*



*Muzaffarpur misusing his official
power against the law.”*

At the outset, the learned counsel for the petitioner seeks not to press the present writ petition, however, seeks liberty on behalf of the petitioner to avail such other alternative remedies as are otherwise available under the law, for redressal of the aforesaid grievances. Liberty, so sought, is granted.
