2 13-04-2023 The present writ petition has been filed seeking the following relief:-

“1. A mandamus commanding the respondents to register the case of the petitioner and demarcate the lands of the petitioner (standing khata no. 88(Old), Plot No. 724(old) in village- Simartoka in the district of Darbhanga) by the



Amin in presence of the concerned parties and got the encroachment removed within prescribed period.”

After some arguments, the learned counsel for the petitioner seeks not to press the present writ petition, however, seeks liberty on behalf of the petitioner to avail such other alternative remedies as are otherwise available under the law. Liberty, so sought, is granted.

The writ petition stands dismissed as not pressed.
