State.

Petitioner apprehends arrest in a case registered for
the offence punishable under sections 147, 149, 341, 323, 307,
504, 506 of the Indian Penal Code.

Allegation against this petitioner is commission of
assault with iron rod on the head of the informant.

It is submitted that informant is own brother of the
petitioner and due to dispute over an ancestral property,
petitioner has been falsely implicated in this case. There is case
and counter case. FIR has been lodged after the delay of one
day.

Learned counsel for the State opposes the bail petition
of the petitioner.



Considering the aforesaid facts and circumstances of the case, in the event of arrest or surrender within six weeks from today, let the petitioner, as named above, be enlarged on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs.10,000/-(ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Chief Judicial Magistrate, Jamui in connection with Jhajha P.S. case no 423 of 2022 subject to the conditions laid down under section 438(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
