2 25-02-2023 Heard learned counsel for the petitioners.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that the injunction petition dated 24.03.2022 under Order 39 Rule 1 and 2 of CPC in Title Suit No.167 of 2021 is pending in the Court of learned Sub-Judge IV, Patna City which is required to be decided on urgent basis but there is no progress in the same and it is in the interest of justice that the said injunction petition be decided expeditiously. He has submitted to dispose of this case



by giving the observation/direction in this regard to the learned Trial Court in the interest of justice.
