2 02-05-2023 This writ application has been filed seeking a direction to the respondents to consider the claim of the petitioners for selection in Home Guard against the reserve post afresh by giving opportunity to appear in the physical examination.

A perusal of the writ application would show that the petitioners were declared unsuccessful during the running process. This Court finds no ground to issue a Mandamus to the respondent authorities to give fresh opportunity to the



petitioners as the process of selection was fixed during a particular period and the same has already come to an end.
