counsel for the informant and learned APP for the State.

In pursuance to the direction of this Court, a report
with regard to the present stage of trial has been received which
has been kept at Flag 'R'.

It is submitted by learned counsel for the informant
that the report of learned 1st Additional Sessions Judge, Saran at
Chapra dated 17.07.2023 suggests that out of seven prosecution
witnesses, two witnesses have already been examined and five
