2 12-04-2023 Learned counsel for petitioner and learned counsel for State present.

The present writ application has been filed for the purpose of proper investigation in connection with Bheldi P.S. Case No. 216 of 2018 lodged under Sections 279/ 337/ 33/ 332/ 333/ 353/ 304/ 427 of the I.P.C.

Counsel for State submits that this case may be disposed off in the light of order passed in *Surendra Singh Vs. The State of Bihar & Ors.* in *Cr. WJC. No. 153 of 2017* and analogous cases decided on 09.09.2022.

In this view of the matter, the present criminal writ petition is **disposed off** with direction to the petitioner to file representation before the Superintendent of Police, Saran at Chapra in the light of the order passed in *Surendra Singh Vs.
