4 12-07-2023 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner, learned counsel for the State, learned counsel for the Bihar State Power Transmission Company and learned counsel for the Accountant General.

2. All the dues in terms of progression and promotion have been specified in paragraphs 5 to 8 of the counter affidavit filed on behalf of the respondents. As per the same, having



joined the services of the respondent board in 1977, the petitioner was granted the following benefits:

(i) Selection grade on 12.11.1988 in the scale of 1400-45-1850-50-2450/- w.e.f. 01.08.1988.

(ii) Super selection grade on 08.09.1995 in the scale of Rs. 1500-50-2000-55-2660/- w.e.f. 09.03.1995.

(iii) He was promoted as Shift In-Charge on 07.01.2004 in the scale of Rs. 4720-150-6070-165-9040/- with grade pay of Rs. 4200/- w.e.f. 07.01.2004.

(iv) He was promoted as Assistant Controller on 13.08.2012 in the scale of Rs. 9300-34800/- with the grade-pay of 4400/- w.e.f. 14.08.2010.

(v) He has also been granted 3rd ACP vide office order dated 09.09.2015 in scale of pay-band-II 9300 to 34800 with the grade-pay of 4400 w.e.f. 01.01.2009.

3. Learned counsel for the petitioner has not pointed out any specific claim which remains due thereafter.

4. The writ petition is, therefore, dismissed.
