2 18-04-2023 After some argument, the learned counsel for the petitioners seeks liberty on behalf of the petitioners to challenge the final order passed by the Circle Officer, Kalyanpur, District-Samastipur, under Section 6(1) of the Bihar Public Land Encroachment Act, 1956, in connection with Encroachment Case No. 1 of 2014-15, by filing appropriate appeal.
