State.

Petitioners apprehend their arrest in a case registered
for the offence punishable under Sections 30a/37 of the Bihar
Prohibition and Excise Act and sections 272, 273, 332, 353,
504/34 of the IPC .

As per the prosecution case, 36 liters liquor was
recovered from the cattle house of co-accused Prakash Das.

Learned counsel appearing for the petitioners submits
that the petitioners are innocent and have falsely been
implicated in this case. Petitioners are wife and mother of said
co-accused. Petitioners have got no criminal antecedent.

Considering the facts of the case, in the event of



arrest/surrender, let the petitioners, above named, be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs.10,000/- (ten thousand) each with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the Additional Sessions Judge II cum Special Judge, Madhubani in Kaluahi Police Station Case No. 168 of 2002, subject to the conditions laid down under section 438(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
