following relief(s):-

*“1. That the petitioner craves indulgence of this
Hon'ble Court for issuance of an appropriate
writ in the nature of Mandamus or any other
writ/writs, order/orders, direction/directions,
command/commands for directing the
respondents to remove illegal construction on
the land which was settled in the name of
